

"WHO IS JESUS TO YOU?"

That is a question that every single person has to answer. Some people will answer like Peter, "...**The Christ, the Son of the Living God**" (Matthew 16:16). Others may say He was a great and wise teacher. He may even be to some, a being they call upon when in a crisis. Other people try to ignore Him all together. But as we already said, life makes it easier to forget who is actually Lord of our life.

So, how do we keep Jesus in the forefront of our lives every day? I have a few suggestions and by no means are they original with me. First, read His word daily. You can sign up for a verse of the day or a daily devotional in your email or sent directly to your smart phone which reminds you to look at God's word while you check your busy schedule. **Psalm 119** encourages us to meditate on God's word all day long. God promised Joshua success and prosperity if he didn't let God's word depart from His mouth.

Secondly, pray all day. No I don't mean sit around in prayer, but offer a prayer of thanks for good things that happen. Praise God in prayer for victories of the day. Pray for those who reveal a need or concern. Pray for protection for all involved whenever you hear the siren of first responders.

Third, think of other's needs before your own. Remind yourself that God values each and every person worthy of the blood of Christ. Look for opportunities to brighten other people's day or do them a favor. Treat people like you want to be treated.

Fourth, know not everybody will appreciate your efforts and may persecute you in some way. That's okay, Jesus told us we are blessed when we are insulted, persecuted and have evil things said about us because we are living for Him!

So who is Jesus to you? I pray that He is the most important part of your life!
